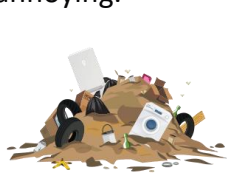

Good news! Someone can do something about it, today, from the comfort of their sofa. All our brilliant village heroes like you.

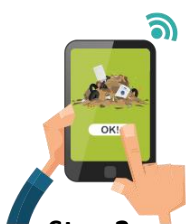

Step 1
See a problem



Step 2
Open the **Love Clean Streets App**



Step 3
Take a picture of the problem. Your location is detected automatically



Step 4
Enter some basic details and post the report in seconds!



Step 5
The local authority system receives and directs the report to the right person/service.

Step 6
The App shows you progress and updates you when the problem is resolved
