Can I Stand for Election?

To stand as a candidate for a parish or town council, you must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a British citizen, a citizen of Ireland, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, or a qualifying EU citizen
- And meet **one** of these conditions:
 - You're registered to vote in the parish
 - You've lived or owned/rented property in the area in the past 12 months
 - You've worked in the area during the past 12 months

How Much Time Does It Take?

Most councillors spend about **3 hours a week** on council duties. This could include attending meetings, chatting with local residents, or working with local groups and organisations.

Will I Get Any Support?

Yes! You'll be given details of relevant training and also learn from your colleagues as you take part in meetings and activities.
